

The <u>Minnesota Milk Bank for Babies</u> (MMBB), a nonprofit organization, collects, processes, and dispenses pasteurized donor human milk to premature and medically vulnerable infants. The mission of MMBB is to improve health outcomes of babies in Minnesota and surrounding states by ensuring that medically fragile infants have access to safe and nutritional donor human milk when mother's milk is unavailable or in low supply.

Position Title: Operations and Logistics Coordinator.

Description: The Operations and Logistics Coordinator works collaboratively across the organization. This position involves ensuring excellent client experience for hospitals, distribution sites, milk donors and recipients. Logistic duties include working with the Depot Coordinators to facilitate donor milk transfers to the milk bank and the Office Coordinator with orders to hospitals, distributions sites, and outpatients. Assists in Production areas with milk processing and order fulfillment as time allows. The position requires clear and effective communication with purchasers and staff at hospitals and distribution sites, milk donors and recipients, and volunteers. The ideal candidate is a strong communicator who is detail-oriented, accurate, collaborative, self-motivated, with strong verbal and written skills, and able to manage multiple projects with various deadlines.

Responsibilities:

Operations & Logistics – 90-95%

- Accurately process donor milk orders to hospitals and distribution sites.
- Communicate with clients about closures, updates, and issues related to product delivery.
- Assist with processing outpatient donor milk orders at the Roseville site.
- Assist Office Coordinator with invoicing orders in QuickBooks Online.
- Ensures an excellent donor experience by facilitating prompt donor milk transfers to the milk bank.
- Collaborate with staff, coordinators, and couriers to arrange greater Minnesota milk transfers to the milk bank by communicating directly with donors, couriers, and FedEx.
- Address any issues with milk transfers when weather, changes to schedules, or other circumstances arise.
- Fulfill requests for supplies, shipping materials, and instructions for sending their milk to the milk bank while maintaining food safety standards.
- Complies with policies related to food safety to ensure donor milk reaches its destination in the appropriate timeframe.
- Document delivery of orders and address any transport issues that may arise.
- Accurately receive and log incoming donor milk and supplies arriving at the milk bank.
- Assist as needed with packing donor milk for shipment to ensure safe arrival of frozen donor milk products to the hospital or distribution site.
- Assist with transfers as needed by picking up milk from metro area depots.

Other Duties – 5-10%

• Assists in Production with tasks such as sorting raw milk, cleaning, and sanitation.
