The mission of the [Minnesota Milk Bank for Babies](#) is to improve infant health outcomes by ensuring that medically vulnerable babies —in Minnesota and the Upper Midwest—have access to safely pasteurized life-giving human donor milk when mother's milk is unavailable or in low supply. The Milk Bank is accredited by the Human Milk Banking Association of North America and licensed by the State of Minnesota as a food manufacturer.
